Preparing assets properly is really important

There are marks for this that are easy to get, but you need to evidence them properly

Preparing assets for comics

It is really important to **evidence** preparation

- detailed screenshots of processes for at least one image
- before and after versions of each image in folder
- screenshots showing before and after to evidence each image has been prepped

In your **assets table**, note **exactly** what has been done to each image

Task:

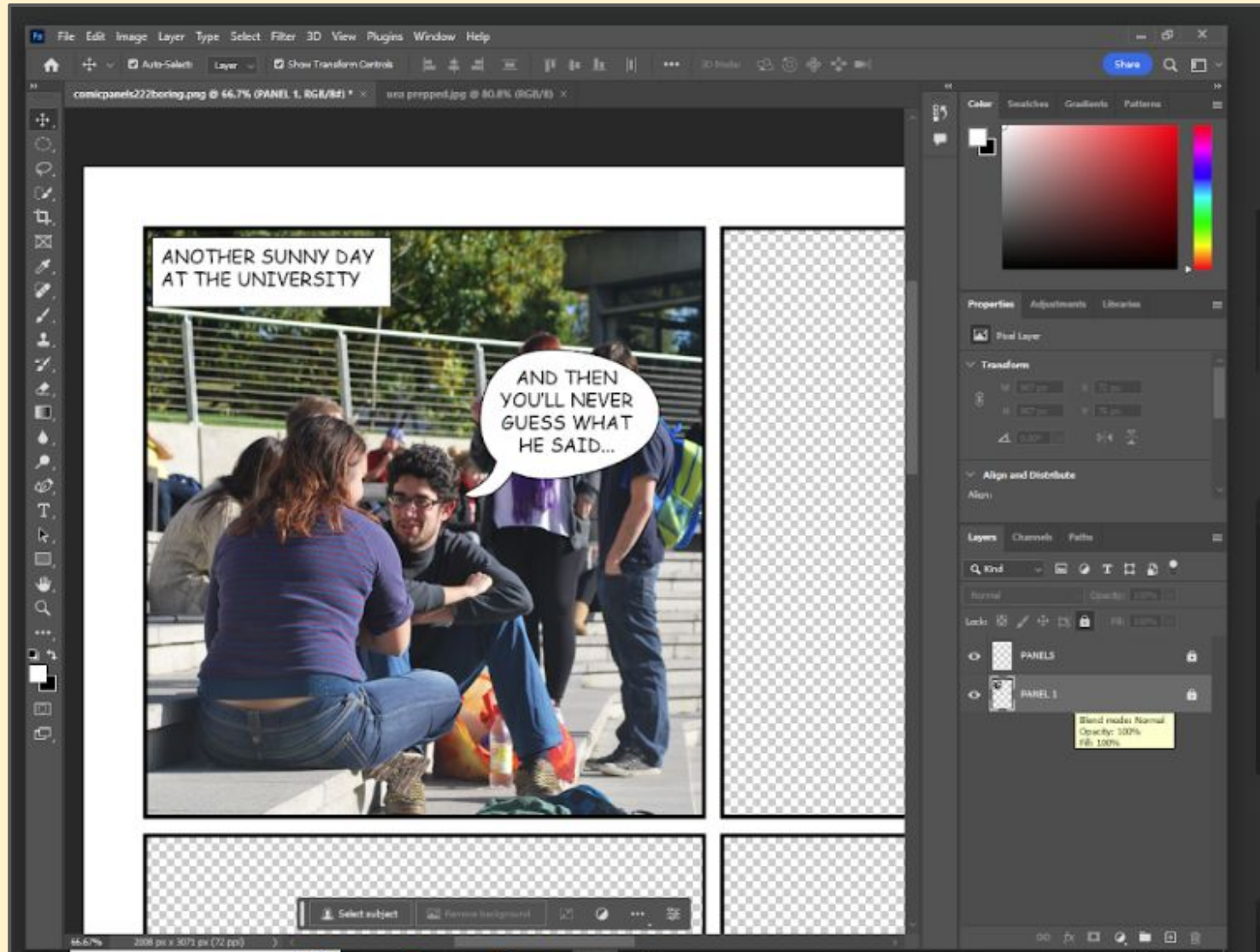
Use an image to create word balloons
