# **Creating a Kapwing Video**

Kapwing is an online video editing website. It's free.

**IMPORTANT:** you **can't save your work** in progress, so you need to make sure that you complete the work and export it in one go

# Creating the Video

- 1. Go to the Kapwing website
- 2. Click the **Start editing** button
- Press Click to Upload to bring in your first piece of video

This opens up a **timeline view** – the bar at the bottom is the key part. There are lots of things you can do here.

# To play the video:

Click the Play button on the <u>left</u> of the timeline

# Adding Media to the Video

#### To add audio:

Click Audio on the <u>left</u> > Click to upload audio > choose audio to upload
 The audio will be put straight into the timeline at the bottom. You can drag it
 around to the right spot in the video

 You can add multiple pieces of audio to the same video



# To add still images:

- Click Media at the left (<u>top left</u> images don't work the same way)
- Click to upload and choose the still image you want to add to the timeline
   You can drag the image around and fade it in or out

#### Adding text titles:

- Click Text on the left
- Choose the type of text to add from the list this adds a text box
- Change the text, colour and font. The **Text Outline option** is really useful





### **Editing the Video**

#### To remove audio already part of the video:

- <u>Right click</u> on the video timeline at the bottom > detach audio > this pops the
  audio out into a separate section of the timeline
- Click on the audio section of the timeline > right click > delete

# Trimming, splitting and deleting video (or audio):

- You can trim a piece of video by dragging it from either end
- You can split the video by clicking at the spot you want to cut it and pressing the Split button near the Play button
- You can delete a video by right click > delete
   The same things work with audio and still images.

#### To fade audio:

- Click on the audio track in the timeline
- Click Effects at the top right
- Choose Fade and then choose intro, outro or both

# **Export the Video**

**IMPORTANT:** To use the video you'll need to export it.



- 1. Click Export Video at the top right
- You will have to export it with a watermark, so click the next box





- 3. **IMPORTANT:** Click **Download file** on the <u>right</u> the work doesn't download until you do this!
- Make sure you move the video to your One
   Drive. It might be a good idea to change the filename
