# Dealing with copyright

Here are some examples of the sorts of things you might include

<b>Open source asset.</b> I can use this any way I want to, including commercially	
<b>I made this myself</b> so am able to use it anyway I want to	
<b>Copyright commons license</b> with freedom to use commercially. I would need to attribute the source of the asset somehow in a final published version of the product, including a link to the original version	
<b>Copyright commons license</b> with no commercial use. Because I can't use the asset commercially I would need to source an alternative asset if I was publishing the final product. Or I could ask for permission to use the asset, paying if necessary	
<b>Copyright asset.</b> I would need to make sure that I either got permission to use the asset or use an alternative asset when I published my final product	
<b>Commercial copyright asset.</b> I would need to pay to use the asset. The price is £XX	
<b>Unknown.</b> I would treat this as a copyright asset and either get permission to use it or use an alternative asset
