## **Testing**

Use a **test table** – there is a template available

Functionality testing (it works or not):

- every button from every page does it work properly?
- videos do they play properly? Do they autoplay or play on click? Are they the right length? Volume levels OK?
- audio as video
- pages have titles that stand out
- fonts are consistent across a section (house style)
- colours are consistent across a section (house style)
- images how **effective** is each image?

Most testing is this kind of test

### **Testing**

### Qualitative testing (the quality of the thing):

- text is easy to read size, font etc...
- colour contrast colour of text on background
- images suitably sized and not distorted; don't overlap text
- use of white space
- Layout is it appropriate; does it work
- video/audio content/length appropriate
- suitable for target audience/client needs
- animations/transitions consistent, work properly, style
  OK?
