# Using Macros in a Quiz

#### Step 1 - Open the PowerPoint

- 1. Download the **bigquiz** PowerPoint and open it
- 2. File > Save a Copy As
- 3. Use the file type <u>drop down</u> to choose Macro Enabled PowerPoint This is <u>IMPORTANT</u>. If you don't do this, you can't include macros

## Step 2 - Lock down the PowerPoint

Slide Show > Set Up Show > tick the Browsed at a Kiosk box > OK
 Run your PowerPoint to check that this has worked

### Step 3 – Open the Macros window:

- 5. View > Macros
- 6. <u>Type</u> the name start\_show in the <u>box at the top</u> > click Create

### Step 4 – First Macro:

We need to start with a macro for the button on Slide 1. Try this:

```
Sub start_show()
score = 0
Application.SlideShowWindows(1).View.GotoSlide Index:=2
End Sub
```

## Step 5 – Add the Macro to the button

- 7. Close the macro window the red cross at the top
- 8. Go to slide 1
- 9. Click on the button on the slide > Insert > Action
- 10. Choose the Run Macro button > choose the macro from the drop down > OK
- 11. **Run** the PowerPoint to check that it works

## Step 6 – Second and Third Macros

On Slide 2 we'll need to use 2 macros:

- one to add a point and go to Slide 3
- the other to just go to Slide 4
- 12. Go back to the macro window: View > Macros > click on a macro > Edit
- 13. Try these macros:

```
Sub question1_correct()
score = score + 1
Application.SlideShowWindows(1).View.GotoSlide Index:=3
End Sub
Sub question1_wrong()
Application.SlideShowWindows(1).View.GotoSlide Index:=4
End Sub
```

## Step 7 – More Macros

On each of slides 3 and 4 we need another two macros:

- one to show the score
- one to go to slide 5
- 14. Try these macros:

```
Sub show_score()
MsgBox "Your score is " & score
End Sub

Sub goto5()
Application.SlideShowWindows(1).View.GotoSlide Index:=5
End Sub
```
