Working with text – advanced tips

There are some clever things you can do with text:

Adding a stroke:

- 1. Highlight the text
- 2. Add a stroke colour at the top left
- 3. Change the stroke weight this depends on the size of the text

Characters

This can make text stand out more effectively

Using bold and italic text


- 1. Highlight the text
- 2. Use the drop down next to the font box (it says **Regular**)
- 3. Choose the effect you want

Different fonts have different effects available

Using SMALL CAPS (DROP CAPS)

- 1. Highlight the text
- 2. Click the <u>Character</u> menu option at the top (next to the font box)
- 3. Click the **Tt button** at the bottom


You can use this menu option in other ways – try increasing the vertical height of the font, for example. Or using some of the other techniques



Rotating text

- 1. Highlight the text
- 2. Click the <u>Transform</u> menu option at the top (the right end of the font menu)
- 3. Use the **angle drop down** try 90 degrees first Again, there are other options here
