


# Building an HTML page

---

## Step 1 – Getting started

1. Open **Notepad** – this is in **Windows Accessories**
2. Use the screenshot to create a basic HTML document



3. **File > Save As** > call the file **newzealand.html**  
– it is **really important** to add the .html bit



File name: newzealand.html  
Save as type: Text Documents (\*.txt)

4. Find the file in your user area. **Double click** it to open it in the web browser

## Step 2 – add some content

5. **Add three things** tourists can see or do in New Zealand. You'll need to look this up on the web
6. Then save – **File > Save** (or **Ctrl+S**)
7. **Open** the file in the web browser again to see the changes

## Step 3 – download the images

8. Download the images for the New Zealand page from the web. These **MUST** be moved into the same folder as you have the **newzealand.html** file saved in. This is **REALLY IMPORTANT**.

## Step 4 – add an image

- To add an image we use an `<img>` tag. Be careful – this gets tricky
- At the **bottom of the page**, add the paragraph in the screenshot and then the map image
- Save** the file and **check it**

```

## Step 5 – a second image

- Next add the `nzimage.jpg` – this needs to go **at the top** underneath the `<h1>` area. Add in the **width** command
- Save** the file and **check it**
- Try **changing** the width number to see what this does to the size of the image

<h1>New Zealand</h1>  

```

## Step 6 – changing fonts

You can change the font. Make sure you include the **closing `</font>` tag** as well.

There are two types of font to try out.

<font face="arial">  
<h1>New Zealand</h1>  
</font>
```

## Step 7 – some color

You can change the colour of the page background. You do this by adding to the body tag at the top.

Note that **color** is spelled the American way.

```
<body bgcolor="red">  
  
<font face="arial">  
<h1>New Zealand</h1>  
</font>
```

## Step 8 – font color and size

You can change the font color by adding to the font tags.

You can also change the size of the font.

Sizes can go from 1 (v small) to 6 (large). Try changing the size and see what happens.
