

Drawing shapes – Owl logo


This introduces some new skills using lines.

Setup Illustrator:


1. **File > New** to create a new Artboard. Make it **200mm** by **200mm**
2. Click **View > View Grid** (at bottom) to show the grid on the Artboard

Drawing an Owl Face:

3. Draw a circle – use the **Ellipse Tool** and hold **SHIFT**. Aim to make your circle about 50mm by 50mm
 - use a **white fill colour** and **black stroke**
 - change the stroke width to something like 5pt
4. On the left toolbar, choose the **Selection Tool** (the top arrow) and click on your circle to select it




5. Copy the circle: **Edit > Copy** (keyboard shortcut: **Ctrl+C**)
6. And paste it: **Edit > Paste** (keyboard shortcut: **Ctrl+V**)
7. Now move the circle so that it's next to the other one. Use the grid to line things up as well as you can




Adding eyeballs:

8. Use the **Ellipse tool** to draw a smaller circle (about 10mm by 10mm) inside one of the larger ones to act as the eyeball
9. **Copy** this circle and use it for the other eye





Adding a beak:

10. Chose the **Rectangle Tool** from the **left toolbar** (click and hold the Ellipse Tool)
11. Draw a **square** to be the beak. Aim for about 25mm by 25mm. Hold **SHIFT** down to get a perfect square.
12. To **rotate** the square, **select** it and click **Object > Transform > Rotate >** change the angle to **45**
13. **Move** the square into position between the eyes. You can use the arrow keys on the keyboard to nudge shapes around.




Add eyebrows

14. Choose the **Pen Tool** from the left toolbar
 15. On the right sidebar, set the **Stroke** to **5pt**
 16. Set the **stroke colour** to **black**
 17. **IMPORTANT:** set the **fill colour** to **transparent** (the red line)
 18. Click **once** above and to the left of your eyes (**point 1**)
 19. Now **click** again at the top edge of the left eye (**point 2**). This starts to draw a line
 20. Continue clicking to **point 4** and then all the way across to **point 7**
- You can undo any mistakes you make – **Edit > Undo**



Styling the eyebrows

21. Click the **Direct Selection Tool** on the left toolbar
22. **Click** on the line and then on the **top left anchor point** (point 1)
23. On the right sidebar, fine the **Convert section** and click the **Smooth curve** button
24. **Repeat** this for the all of other anchor points **EXCEPT THE MIDDLE ONE**



Adjust the nose

25. Use the **Direct Selection Tool** to pull the top of the nose upwards a little to give it a better shape
