Presenting to an audience

Working in a group, create a presentation about **cyberbullying**

The **audience** for the work is Year 7 children

You will **present** your presentation to the class next lesson

The presentation should last **3 to 4 minutes**

Cyberbullying presentation

Presenting to an audience

Your presentation needs to include at least one slide per person in your group

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Presenting to an audience

Your presentation should:

- **Describe** what cyberbullying is
- Give **examples** of different ways cyberbullying might happen
- **Explain** what problems cyberbullying causes
- **Explain** what people should do if they come across cyberbullying
- Include **text** and **images** on every slide

Cyberbullying presentation

Step 1:

Decide on a group leader

Make a plan - who is going to do what?

- Everyone must be involved in the presentation to the class
- Everyone must be involved in creating slides

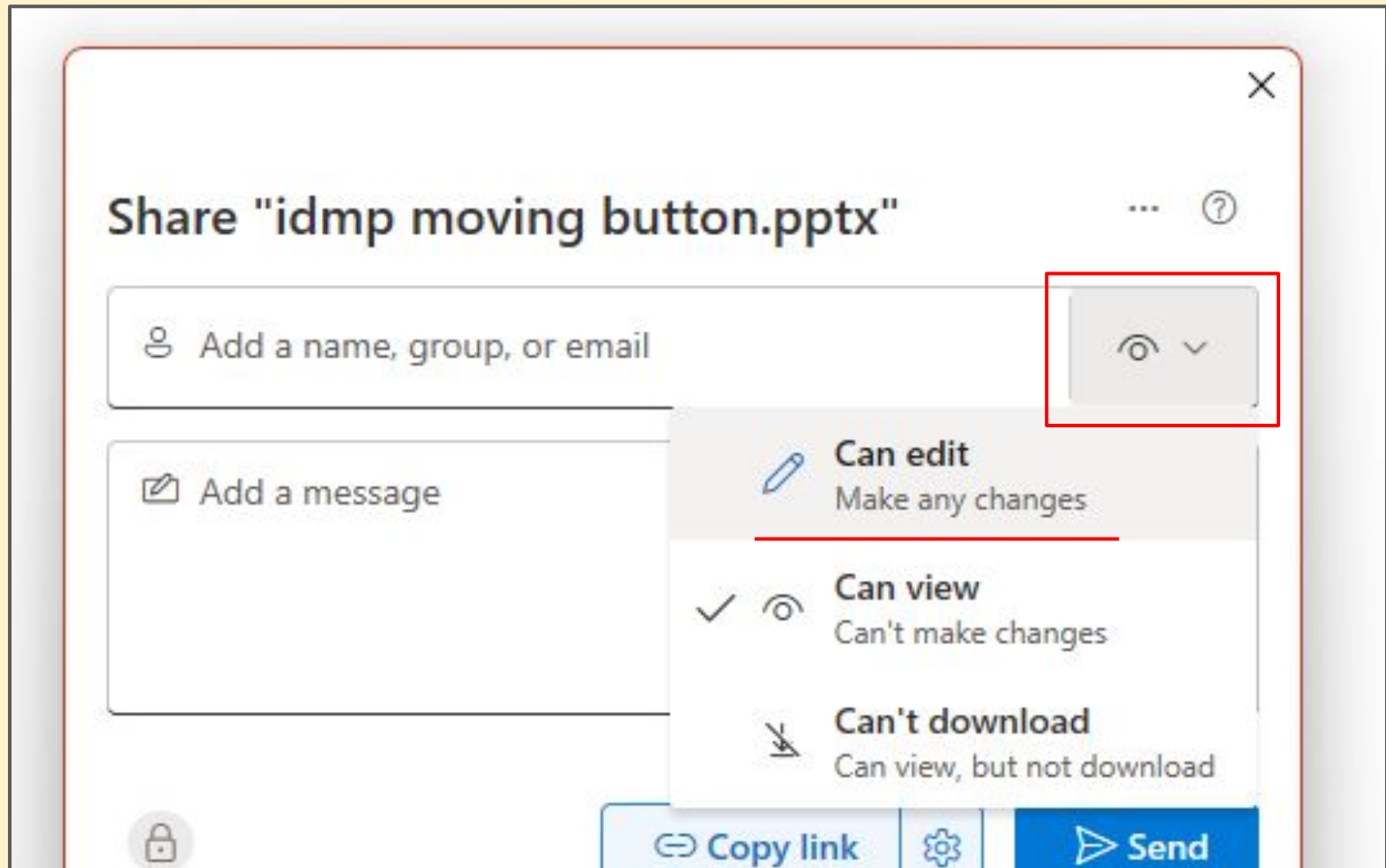
Decide on a colour scheme and which fonts to use

Cyberbullying presentation

Step 2:

- The group leader creates a new presentation
- The title page needs a title and the names of the people in the group
- Save it in your OneDrive
- Share it with the other members of the group **so that they can edit it**

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Step 3:

- Create the slides
- Make sure you know who is responsible for each slide

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Step 4:

- Plan what you're going to say
