

Animated Ducks – prepare the ducks


NOTE: You will need to have the ducks image downloaded. **Rename** it when you do as it doesn't have a very helpful filename

1. Open **Photoshop 2023**
2. **File > Open >** find the duck image file and open it

Square cropping


3. Choose the **Crop tool** on the left toolbar
4. At the top, change the box that says **Ratio** to **1:1 (Square)**
(Square)

This forces a perfectly square crop which will look cooler



5. **Crop** the image so that only one duck is showing

6. **IMPORTANT:** At the top, **click the tick** to confirm the crop



It's helpful to zoom in at this point


Unlock the layer

IMPORTANT: we need to unlock the background before we can remove it

7. Find the **Lock icon** in the **Layer Stack** at the bottom right of the screen



8. **Double click** the **lock icon** > click **OK** on the popup

This should remove the lock



Removing the background

- Find the **Object Selection Tool** - it's on the left toolbar just above the Crop tool
- Click and hold** the mouse down on this tool > choose the **Quick Selection Tool**
- Use the **quick selection tool** to select the background of the image – not the duck. Click and drag it around the outside.
- If you make a mistake, click **Select > Deselect** to start again
- Press the **Delete key** on the keyboard to remove the background
- IMPORTANT:** if a popup box appears, press **Cancel** and go back to **Step 7** and unlock the layer.




Exporting the duck as a PNG

- Click **File > Export As**
- Check the box at the **top right** says **PNG** and that the **Transparency** is ticked
- Click **Export** at the **bottom**. Call the export **DUCK YELLOW**

Changing the colour

- REALLY IMPORTANT:** your duck is probably still selected. Click **Select > Deselect** to remove the selection lines
- At the **top**, click **Layer > New Adjustment Layer > choose Hue/Saturation > OK**
- Look on the **right** of the screen above the Layer Stack and find the Hue and Saturation sliders
- Drag the **Hue slider** a little way to the **left** until the duck turns orange – if this doesn't work, **delete** the Hue/Saturation layer and **go back to step 18**



- Click **File > Export As > check it is a PNG > Export**. Call the file **duck orange**
- Now drag the slider further **left** until the duck is **red**. Export this as **duck red**
- Keep doing this to create many different colours of duck

Export each duck. This creates a flock of coloured ducks
