A Cooler Record Company Logo

First make sure you have the simple record company logo made

We're going to:

- add a central section
- add the record grooves

Draw a central circle:


- Find the Rectangle Tool on the <u>left toolbar</u>. Click and <u>hold it</u> until a new set of tools appears
- 2. Choose the **Ellipse Tool**
- 3. **Hold <u>SHIFT</u> down** and draw a smaller yellow circle to act as the centre of the record. Change the fill colour to make it yellow (or something that will work for you)
- 4. Don't forget to hold SHIFT down to get a perfect circle
- 5. Click the **two buttons** in the **Align section** to place the circle **exactly** in the centre of the artboard



Adjust the Text


You'll probably have to adjust the text now

- 6. To move the text to the front, Click on it using the **Selection Tool** (the top arrow on the **left toolbar**) > click **Order** at the **top** > **Arrange** > **Bring to front**
- 7. You might need to change the colour of the text so that it shows up. **BUT**, it's even better to use a **stroke layer style**:
 - a. select the text using the Type Tool
 - b. in the <u>right sidebar</u>, change the **Stroke colour** to something that will work well – black is often a good choice



- c. adjust the Stroke Weight (thickness) if needed
- d. use the **Selection Tool** to drag the text around if necessary

Once you're happy with your text, move on to the grooves



Adding Grooves

Vinyl records have a groove that runs around them. The logo will look a lot better with this




- 8. Create another circle (hold down

 SHIFT) just outside the yellow one (so, a bit bigger)
 - Make the **Stroke Colour** a dark grey (the next shade down from black) and the **Stroke Weight** 0.5 pt. Change the **Fill Colour** to transparent the red diagonal line
- 9. Use the same two buttons in the **Align section** to get the circle in the centre of the artboard

Now we need to get more circles. There's a quick way to do this...

- At the top click Effects > Distort and Transform > Transform
- Change the Horizontal and Vertical Scale boxes <u>at the</u> top to both read 105%. At the <u>bottom</u>, change the Copies box to 25. Then click OK
- 12. This should create a set of grooves. You can always use the **Select tool** to change the size of your first circle a bit if you need to



Save and Export

- 13. Save your work: File > Save As > give your file a sensible name and make sure you're saving it in your OneDrive
 - The file will save as an **Adobe Illustrator** (ai) file
- 14. **Export** your work: **File** > **Export** > **Export** As > choose **PNG file type** from the dropdown. When the next box appears, check:
 - the **resolution** is set to High (300ppi)
 - the background is transparent
- 15. Click OK

This will export your logo as a PNG file which can be used easily
