There are key things that need to go on each side

Iguana Records want their logo to go on the back. You'll need to make that first



































Back Front

Things to include:

- song listing (usually numbered)
- record company logo/name often some kind of address as well
- bar code
- credits producer, mixer, song writer etc...
- website/social media addresses
- copyright statement and date produced (e.g.
 © 2024)

Some back covers use quite plain or angle colour backgrounds







Others are mainly plain with a single image, often of the artist - usually off to one side (but

not always)







Others are more complex - which makes them

tricky to design








Mainly plain, single colour background to make it easy to read the track listing

Bonus tracks (common on CDs as opposed to vinyl)

Note how nothing's too close the the edge. Make sure you have some breathing space
