CD Cover – Astronaut 1

- 1. Open **PhotoPaint** press **Alt** + **S** to get rid of the pop up
- On the <u>right panel</u>, make sure you are clicked on **Objects** If you lose the right panel, click **Window > Dockers > Objects** to get it back

Use Astronaut Image 1. This is all about understanding how the Tolerance works


- 3. **REALLY IMPORTANT:** First, go **Object > Create > From Background**
- 4. Crop the image to remove as much of the background as possible
- 5. Try the Magic Wand Tool with Tolerance set to 10 (click and hold on the Rectangle Mask Tool)
 This isn't great the helmet and parts of the arm on the right of the image also get selected
- Rectangle Mask R
 Ellipse Mask J
 Magic Wand Mask W
 Lasso Mask A

- 6. Remove the mask (Mask > Remove Mask)
- 7. At the <u>top</u>, change the Tolerance to 1 and try

 This is too low there are lots of specks
- 8. **Remove** the mask
- Set the Tolerance to 5 and try again
 This is OK, although the arm on the right needs cleaning up
- Switch to the Brush Mask Tool it's under the Magic
 Wand Tool so click and hold
- 11. Hold SHIFT on the keyboard and use the Brush Mask Tool to add any parts that need adding You can hold CONTROL down to remove any parts of the background that accidentally get selected



- 12. **Save** as a **PNG**
- 13. **Remove** the mask (Mask > Remove Mask) and copy and paste the image
