Setup

- 1. Open Corel Draw
- 2. Create a New Document
- Change the settings as shown in the screenshot: 3.
 - a. IMPORTANT: primary colour mode set to RGB
 - b. width 200mm
 - c. height 200mm
 - d. resolution 300dpi
- Click **OK** to create the new document 4.
- On the right panel, make sure you're clicked on Properties 5. If you lose the right panel, **Window** > **Dockers** > **Properties** will get it back

Draw a circle

- On the <u>left toolbar</u>, click the **Ellipse Tool**
- 7. **Hold down** the **Control key** on the keyboard and draw a circle big enough to fill most of the canvas The control key makes sure you get a perfect circle
- On the **left toolbar**, switch to the **Pick Tool** the arrow at the top
- 9. IMPORTANT: At the top, click Object > Align and Distribute > choose Center to Page


This will get the circle exactly in the centre of the page

Adding colour

So far you have a circle with a thin black outline


- 10. On the **right** of the screen, click on the **Properties tab**
- 11. At the **top** of the **right sidebar**, click the **Fill icon** (paint tin)
- 12. Select the **Uniform Fill** icon
- 13. Change the colour to black





Ellipse tool (F7)

Draw circles and ellips

- 14. Create a smaller circle as the inside of the record. Fill this a colour like yellow
- 15. IMPORTANT: Centre it Object > Align and Distribute > Centre to Page

Adding the Grooves

- 16. Draw a third circle, just a bit bigger than the centre one
- 17. Make the outline white (on the right panel)Don't fill this circle. You need it transparent with an outline
- 18. IMPORTANT: Object > Align and Distribute > Centre to Page
- Switch to the **Pick Tool** and make sure you're clicked on the groove
- 20. At the top, click **Window** > **Dockers** > **Transform**This adds a new panel on the right
- 21. Pick **Scale and Mirror** from the top right
- 22. Set the X and Y values to 105%
- 23. Set the Copies value to 30 > click Apply
 - a. If you have too many grooves, undo (Edit >
 Undo) and change the value for Copies to be fewer than 30
 - b. If you have too few grooves, undo and make Copies a bigger number. This is trial and error

Add Lettering

- 24. Switch to the Text Tool on the left toolbar
- 25. **Add lettering** use the **text outline** setting to really make your lettering stand out
- 26. Save your work this will save it as a Corel Draw file
- 27. **Export** your work as a PNG: **File** > **Export** > Change the **file format** to **PNG**
