Saving and exporting work

You need to:

- Save your work as a PhotoPaint file so it can continue to be edited
- 2. **Export** your work as a **JPEG** so you can use it somewhere else PowerPoint, a website etc...

Both of these steps are **essential**

Saving and exporting work

Saving work as a PhotoPaint file:

- 1. Click File > Save As
- 2. Check that you're saving in your **OneDrive**
- 3. It's best to save your work **in a folder** where you can find it easily
- 4. Give the file a **sensible name man edit v1** for example
- 5. Save the work

Saving and exporting work

Exporting work as a JPEG:

- 1. Click **File** > **Export**
- 2. Check that you're saving in your **OneDrive**
- 3. Change the **Save as type** drop down to **JPEG**
- 4. Give the file a **sensible name** use v1, v2....
- 5. Click **OK**
- 6. A pop up appears click Save Flattened
- 7. A large pop up appears click **OK**
