## CD Cover - Square Crop

CD Covers are square. This means you need to be able to crop and image so that it's perfectly square

You need to have an image to use **saved** to your **OneDrive** first


- Open PhotoPaint press Alt + S to get rid of the pop up 1.
- 2. Click File > Open > find your image and open it
- 3. Choose the **Crop Tool** from the **left toolbar**
- **VERY IMPORTANT:** Hold the **Control key** down 4.
- 5. Start at the **top left** and **drag** out the **bottom right** to select a crop area

You should find that holding Control down makes the crop area perfectly square **IMPORTANT:** make sure to stay on the canvas to get a perfect square **IMPORTANT:** let go of the mouse **before** you let go of Control. This keeps it square



- you can drag the crop area around if you need to – but this can be tricky
- you can **resize** the crop area from the **corner** (**<u>not</u>** the edges)
- if it all goes wrong, click **Clear** at the **top left** and start over
- 7. Once you have the right crop area selected, click Crop at the top left
- 8. You can always undo - Edit > Undo (or Control + Z)
- 9. **Save** your image now with a new name – **File** > **Save** 
  - As > make sure you're in your OneDrive > use a <u>new name</u> for the file It's important to use a **new filename** so that you can go back to the original image if you need to







Now you can move on to editing the image
