

# The Calculator

Python is really good at doing maths. And really quick at it

Create a calculator

The calculator should take two **integers** and perform one of the basic **mathematical operators**: addition; subtraction; multiplication; or division

It should give the answer

# The Calculator

## Data types:

Don't forget, Python thinks anything the user enters is a **string** (a word)

We will need to tell it to convert the string to an **integer** (a whole number)

# The Calculator

## Data types:

Python is fussy

It thinks the string “A” is different to “a”

It does this because of the way letters are stored as numbers

To deal with this we will need to **convert** the string for the **operator** to **upper case**
