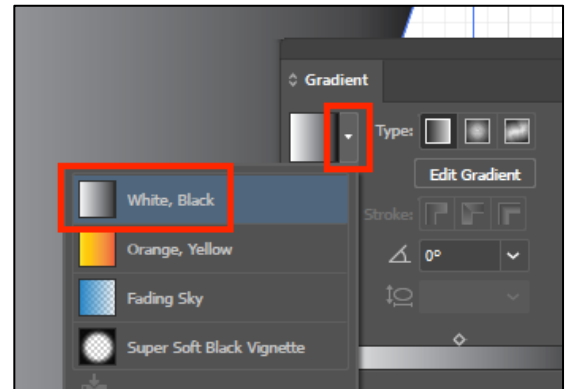


# Working with shapes – gradient fill

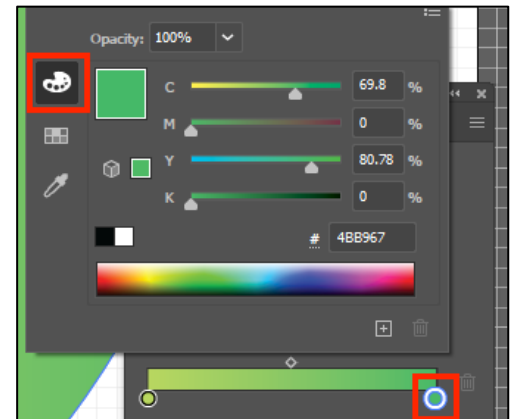
1. **Select** the shape that you want to fill
2. At the **top**, click **Window > Gradient**
3. This pops out a **Gradient box** from the **right sidebar**
4. Use the **drop down** next to the coloured box to choose a **White, Black gradient**

This will remove any colour from your shape.  
That's OK



## Set the colours

5. **Double click** on the **left slider** on the **gradient bar** and set it to a light version of the colour you want to be the base for the fill
6. The best way to choose colours is to use the artists palette
7. **Double click** on the **right slider** and choose a darker version of the same colour
8. This creates a gradient fill



## Things to try

9. Experiment with different colours
10. While you're clicked on **one of the sliders**, change the **opacity** to **60%** to make one side of the fill partly transparent
11. Change the **angle box** to **45 degrees**. You can experiment with different angles to see what effect it has on the fill
12. **Save** your work and then **export** it as a **PNG file** (**File > Export > Export As**)
